On Saturday, March 30th, from 12 to 4 p.m., a.antonopoulou.art gallery presents the new solo exhibition by **Alexandros Phsychoulis**.

Following the large installations the artist made in the early 2000s, he has now returned to painting. One of the works from that previous period titled "The Room", (of white and black yarn and sound in variable dimensions) which was exhibited at a.antonopoulou art in 2009, is now in the permanent collection of TATE in London, presented as part of the D.Daskalopoulos Collection Gift 2023.

His new exhibition at the gallery is entitled "**Attribution**".

In early September 2023, severe flooding caused by Storm Daniel, washed away Alexandros Psychoulis's house in South Pelion. He, himself, managed to leave the house only a few minutes before its collapse.

The new series of paintings produced after this disaster, is a "therapeutic", playful and at the same time, tender look at the ferocity of the phenomenon.

Concepts of habitation, security and stability in the new climatic conditions, develop around the central narrative axis, the storm's birth and abatement.

Large-scale works with repetitive, almost obsessive artistic writing, stand like a prayer and absolution towards a weather phenomenon, while at the same in full awareness that weather phenomena have no need for our forgiveness.
